A brand new day -8x26'

The documentary series offers a poignant immersion into the journey of transgender people before, during, and after their gender-affirming surgery. Through intimate testimonies and never-before-seen footage, the series highlights the challenges, hopes, and transformations experienced by patients, while revealing the work of the healthcare professionals involved in this process. This documentary stands out for its sensitive and respectful approach, aiming to demystify gender-affirming surgeries and raise public awareness of the realities experienced by trans people.



Alexandre Dumas, lust for life - 1x52'

Through the lesser-known works of one of the world's most famous writers, Dumas, des mets et des mots explores Alexandre Dumas' life from a fresh perspective. From the forests of Picardy to Roscoff and the Caucasus mountains, the documentary takes us on a journey tracing the footsteps of this unique artist, known for his insatiable appetite. A key event is a banquet held in Dumas' childhood home, where a chef reimagines dishes from his Grand Dictionnaire de Cuisine, published posthumously. Revisiting this work reveals a complex figure shaped by a turbulent family history, a thirst for social justice, and an exuberance for life that epitomized the 19th century. How did this grandson of a slave become a literary giant?



Animals inside out

Survival is a game of strategy. This two-part series unveils the remarkable skills that have allowed wild animals to endure for millions of years—sometimes as predators, sometimes as prey.



Beginner at autism

- 1x52'

A year ago, Louis T. received his diagnosis in his psychologist's office: he has had Asperger's syndrome, a form of autism spectrum disorder, his entire life. Since coming out to the media last year, he's been flooded with questions from the public every day.

Faced with these inquiries, Louis feels completely at a loss. Yes, the diagnosis has been incredibly liberating for him, but there's one truth that troubles him: «The truth is, I know nothing about autism. I'm new to this!» he says. It's to answer these questions—and especially his own about autism—that the comedian embarks on a documentary journey, like an apprentice eager to learn everything about this new chapter of his life.




Below, underwater territories - 5x24' - In

A group of divers will lift the veil on the oceans mysteries by giving a close-up look at the underwater fauna and flora. Choosing to free dive and not to share their diving coordinates in order to not disturb the biodiversity, these eco-divers educate us about a world that is so close to us but yet unknown to the greater number.



Bless our breasts - 1x90' or 1x52'

Bless our breasts is a documentary that explores the perception and representation of the female chest in society. It examines how this part of the body, often sexualized, is shaped by social and cultural expectations. The film looks at the pressures faced from a young age, when the chest becomes a symbol of femininity, and addresses practices such as "breast flattening" and cosmetic surgery, which alter bodies to fit certain societal ideals. Through testimonies and analysis, the documentary examines how these norms affect body image and invites reflection on the relationship women have with their own bodies.



Daily science - 13x52'- In production

Daily Science is the documentary series that will help you understand your day to day life through the lense of science. Each episode will focus on one topic and tackle questions we all asked ourselves at least once. How does our body work, what is really in my plate, what is the purpose of this technology, ...? Echoes of the Sahara

- 2x52'

For eight months, Justine and Thomas are traveling by bicycle from Paris to Dakar. These two adventure enthusiasts have been leading eco-expeditions for several years. Involved in environmental organizations and giving talks on eco-adventures, this year they have decided to undertake a documentary project to get as close as possible to the field and its realities. Their journey from Paris to Dakar aims to discover what solutions local people in the Saharan region are developing to face the challenges of climate change. This major adventure will be divided into two distinct but complementary documentaries. The first, set in Tunisia and Algeria, explores how Saharan communities are combating drought—perhaps the greatest challenge facing all desert inhabitants. After addressing this broad issue, the second documentary, from Morocco to Senegal, focuses on Saharan housing and the solutions developed to ensure its sustainability. These two films will be connected through the human adventure of traveling from Paris to Dakar, which will serve as a backdrop and an invitation to watch both films to gain a comprehensive view of the solutions emerging across the Saharan region. The climate issues we wish to explore are complementary: if no solutions are found to limit the impact of drought, some areas will eventually become uninhabitable.



Eurodyssey: a journey through Europe's rivers - 1x52

From the English Channel to the Black Sea, Eurodyssey is a kayak journey across Europe, meeting those who fight for the survival of our waterways. It's six months spent on the water — feeling its power, moving forward day after day, and sleeping each night by its side. Along the way, encounters made on or near the water will give a voice to the canals, rivers, and streams crossed, helping the audience realize that our waterways are more than static geographical features. Our rivers are alive — but they can also die. They are homes, timeless communication routes, natural borders, and cultural symbols that were once even elevated to the status of deities (for instance, in ancient Celtic mythology, the River Seine was seen as the goddess Sequana, whose cult was closely tied to that of water). This film seeks simply to remind us of that ancient reality — and of the crucial role rivers will play in the world of tomorrow.



Fletcher street - 1x52' - In production

In North Philadelphia's Strawberry Mansion, where poverty, violence, and racism define the streets, the Fletcher Street stables stand as an unexpected refuge. This documentary follows Main, a 17-year-old African American who has faced trauma, loss, and the lure of gangs. Every morning, he crosses blocks of abandoned houses to reach the horses that give him calm, strength, and hope. Through his journey, the film captures the struggles and dreams of a generation fighting for identity, dignity, and a place in society. Visceral, emotional, and timely, it's more than a portrait of one young man—it's a window into the realities of today's youth, and the power of community to rewrite their future.



Free way - 1x52' or 1x90'



Free Way dives into the mind and creativity of chef Raül Balam. Marked by years of drug addiction, his path to excellence in the culinary world was far from easy. Inspired by his mother, renowned chef Carme Ruscalleda, Raül overcame his struggles to rediscover himself. Blending high-level cuisine with his bold Instagram persona, this documentary follows his journey after the closure of Sant Pau, his mother's 3-star restaurant.



Hey, check out my penis - 1x45'

This film explores the phenomenon of «dick pics»—unsolicited photos of penises—by examining the motivations of the men who send them and the impact on those who receive them. Through firsthand accounts, expert analysis, and a non-judgmental approach, the documentary examines themes such as desire, power, exhibitionism, narcissism, sexism, and fear of rejection. The aim is to understand the reasons behind this phenomenon and to open a dialogue on sexuality and consent.

Hope - 6x52'



Hope is a six-part series that takes us on a journey to discover powerful solutions to climate change, told through personal stories across four continents. Narrated by Jane Goodall and Gael García Bernal, it explores how farmers, scientists, activists, and others are changing the world.



Islands untold - 2x52'

The French Overseas Territories still hold little-known treasures, secret territories whose discovery is well worthwhile. To explore them, you must be willing to step away from the obvious, meet those who know their mysteries, and be willing to surpass yourself. This is the goal set for themselves by the passionate duo Sabine Quindou and Yves Paccalet.



Kayaking the river Somme - 1x52'

Tortuga, a young explorer who has just returned from an adventure in Lapland — having already crossed Iceland on foot and lived like a nomad in Mongolia — is now embarking on a new adventure, closer to home and more human: kayaking down the Somme River. A journey marked by the discovery of the region's heritage and the warm welcomes of his followers who track his progress along the way.



Life at the vet - 26x26'

Vet Life follows Dr. Raymond Plasse and his team through the hectic days of a veterinary hospital, where small joys follow major dramas. Each episode offers an authentic glimpse into the daily lives of veterinarians, from animal care and difficult decisions to bonding with their four-legged friends. The series highlights the passion, challenges, and emotions experienced by those who dedicate their lives to animal health.



Life in the heights - 1x52'

In the Pyrenees, a bold shepherdess and a secretive bear share the same mountain. They both keep watch: one over her daughter and her flock, the other over her two cubs. Each, in her own way, safeguards the delicate balance of life in the mountains. Will they ever meet?



Life on the rocks - 1x52'

The mountain goat is a legendary being and one of the toughest animals. It eats anything, endures extreme cold and heat, and inhabits the steepest landscapes in the world, where no one can follow it. In the last National Park in Europe, Guadarrama Peaks, there is a thriving colony of male goats. We will attend their impressive fights, their funny courtships and their incorrect sexuality. We will see how a large male grows and dies, as a mirror of what happens to the species that is increasingly threatened with extinction.



Limitless love - 10x26'

Limitless love follows the journey of six single people living with a difference as they seek love. Accompanied by matchmakers, they embark on blind dates, exploring the challenges and prejudices associated with their differences. Through their stories, the series highlights the realities of dating for people with disabilities, while celebrating diversity and inclusion.



Menstrual revolution

Millions of women worldwide, between the ages of 15 and 50, experience the menstrual cycle—an event that occurs nearly 450 times over the course of their lives. Yet, for centuries, menstruation has been shrouded in ignorance, taboo, and suffering.

Today, however, a new paradigm is emerging, embraced by thousands of women across the globe who advocate for a more open, conscious, and empowering approach to their menstrual health.



Post-war France: the challenge of reconstruction - 1x52'

In 1945, the entire French territory was finally liberated after five years of war and occupation.

But the destruction inflicted on the country during these dark years was terrible. Once the war was over, bridges, roads, and factories had to be rebuilt. The victims had to be rehoused, and the cities had to be rebuilt. A titanic task.

So, extraordinary forces were deployed throughout France. In just 10 years, the country would recover.

In Royan as in Marseille, in Brest as in Le Havre, engineers and architects would recreate entire cities, invent new forms, new structures, and rebuild using new and innovative techniques.

This would be the great adventure, crazy and ingenious, tragic and exciting, of the Reconstruction of France.



Riviera food tour - 20x26'

Elian and Rodrigue set off to discover the emblematic regions of the Riviera and its characteristic ingredients, with a touch of humor.



Sentinels of Antarctica

- 1x52'

For 70 years, Antarctica — the continent at the very bottom of the planet — has been protected by an international treaty that designates it as a safeguarded land: a continent without borders, without weapons, and whose resources are not exploited. Argentina and Chile are the countries closest to Antarctica and, for that reason, claim a permanent presence on the peninsula. For Argentina, this presence even extends to supporting families who take turns living there each year, despite the harsh climate. Travel writer Cédric Gras sets out to meet these families at the Esperanza Base. In total, eight families, including 18 children aged 4 to 16, live amid gentoo penguins, Weddell seals, and sea lions, enduring temperatures as low as -45°C and winds exceeding 150 km/h. It is an extraordinary adventure for the southernmost human colony on the planet, whose permanent presence is primarily driven by geopolitical interests



Shapers of tomorrow - Season 2 - 12x52'

The Shapers of Tomorrow are back for a second season. Scientists, engineers, researchers, architects, teachers, they are all working towards a better future whether it is in health security, transport, environment, ... From great discoveries to new technologies, they are behind the discoveries and inventions that will design our future life to make it brighter, smarter and more sustainable.



Storks & lions adapt or die - 1x52'

Wildlife is deeply affected by human activity. In the last 1500 years 900 species have disappeared for ever, many others, like lions, could meet the same end soon. However, some animals, such as white storks, have adapted to our presence. They have changed their behavior, their migrating habits, their reproductive pattern, the places where they nest and even their diet. And so, they are proliferating! On the contrary, it would seem that lions do not know how to adapt to us. Out of half a million, today only 20,000 survive! Every species influences the rest, but we are quickly modifying landscapes and ecosystems and changing all rules. We may be forcing things a little too much?



Tasting the world - 10x52'

Pizza, French Fries, Sandwiches, Pastries: those meals are among the most globally eaten. Yet, can you tell confidently that you really know them? Where do they come from? How are they made? Where can you find their best representatives? From their history to their most remarkable fabrication secrets, there is so much about them you can't simply find in a plate. With the new collection "Tasting the World", it's finally time to get the answers you deserve about these inescapable meals. Travel the world, from Paris to New York, and discover the surprising secrets of our most beloved food!



The golden owl hunt

- 1x90'

This documentary tells the astonishing story of a game that escaped its creators, transforming into the world's longest treasure hunt. On one side, a marketing plan established in 1993 based on the idea of two men: an ambitious advertising executive who conceptualized a truly accomplished treasure hunt, and a wealthy artist in search of fame. On the other, hundreds of thousands of players in France and abroad. At the center, a solid gold owl worth 1 million old francs, or nearly 150,000 euros, is up for grabs. Nothing will go as planned. The treasure hunt will last much longer than predicted in the business plan, and the game's two creators will engage in a veritable battle of egos. The immense community of «owlhunters»—as they call themselves—that formed in 1993 will take over the game, now the world's longest treasure hunt. The adventure has lasted for more than thirty years, punctuated by interventions from bailiffs, lawyers, and conspiracy theories.



The green island lab

- 1x52'

The island of Réunion is one of the first overseas territories to commit to the fight against climate change. Increasingly exposed to the effects of global warming, it aims to completely phase out fossil fuels by 2030. This transition is built on an energy mix that combines abundant natural resources—sun, wind, water, and biomass—with technological innovation. The Réunion model relies on an alliance between researchers, industry leaders, and public decision-makers. It transforms the constraints of insularity into opportunities, making Réunion a true, full-scale laboratory for the energy transition of the territories of the future.



The journey to parenthood: challenges of assisted reproduction - 1x90' or 1x52'

Medicine today offers unprecedented possibilities to fulfill the desire to have a child, which is truly remarkable. Yet, the journey of Medically Assisted Procreation (MAP) remains a challenging experience for many. Illness, loss, long waiting times, impact on daily life, invasive and sometimes painful procedures... this path carries a significant physical and emotional cost. Many women feel, at best, inadequately supported, and at worst, infantilized or burdened with quilt. As is often the case in reproductive health, access to information is limited, the sense of agency over one's body can be compromised, and resources are frequently insufficient to meet needs. What can one expect today when all they desire is something life cannot grant naturally: a child? And what should we demand from our institutions to ensure that MAP becomes truly accessible and equitable for everyone?



The sunriders - 1x52'

The story of Matthieu and Damien, two 24 years old friends who decide to set off on an adventure after their studies. They set themselves the challenge of cycling from France to Singapore. From the Iranian hospitality, to the Buddhist temples of Thailand, through the desert regions of Central Asia, the movie retraces their adventures, difficulties and encounters along the way. An inspiring, emotional and epic movie that will undoubtedly inspire you to set off on your own.



The threat of the pantanal - 1x52'

The Brazilian Pantanal is an exuberant, wild and spectacular sanctuary. But this year, the rains have not come and the waters have not risen, so the behavior of the animals here is going to be profoundly altered. Millions of alligators, howling monkeys and the fearsome marabunta live this delicate ecosystem. Birds, insects and enormous tarantulas of a thousand colors will have to manage to eat and drink this so strange year... Many of the world natural paradises today are hot spots that have been severely damaged and could be about to disappear...



Unconventional families - 13x26'

The series explores atypical families who choose to live differently — whether they are nomadic, minimalist, multigenerational, early retirees, self-sufficient in the woods, or those who follow more alternative models.



Urbex mountains - 1x52'

While brownfield sites, old buildings, etc., are most often found in urban areas, Anthony Binst takes us to the mountains. An exploratory journey with Jean Toub, a pioneer of urbex, who will guide Anthony to long-forgotten places: summer camps, holiday villages, dying ski resorts... A dive into the 70s and 80s, into this past that today disfigures the landscapes, to discover places that a few crazy people have decided to revive.



Vanished: Victoria Charlton investigates

The documentary series delves into cases of mysterious disappearances in Quebec. Hosted by YouTuber and true crime author Victoria Charlton, the series explores unsolved cases often overlooked by mainstream media. In each episode, Victoria conducts field investigations, interviews witnesses, consults archives, and enlists the help of her community to gather new information and attempt to advance the investigations. The first season focuses on the disappearances of Francis Albert-Cloutier, Philippe Lajoie, and Mélissa Blais. The second season expands the investigation to other cases, including those of Nathalie Champigny, Nathalie Godbout, and Linda Normandin, providing fresh perspectives and deepening the research to provide answers to the families involved.

For millennia, humanity has gazed at the sky in search of meaning—a universal quest that connects us across time and civilizations. Long before the Greek scholars, the Babylonians invented a celestial language still in use today: the zodiac. An international team of astronomers, historians, and archaeologists brings this forgotten revolution back to life, from cuneiform tablets to giant telescopes, revealing how these pioneers anticipated our algorithmic thinking and shaped a shared cosmic legacy.

A year at Pic du Midi 1x52'

The Pic du Midi de Bigorre is a multi-faceted mountain, an old lady whose history is rich in several lives and whose aura dominates an entire territory. With the installation of a scientific platform, then an astronomical observatory, with its recent opening to the general public, it has been able to constantly evolve and reinvent itself. To portray this mountain is to hear the science that is practiced there, the history that is transmitted there, the tourism that it engenders, the poetry that emerges from it. "The 4 seasons of the Pic du Midi" accompanies this old lady over time, listening to fall asleep at fall, roar in winter, calm down in spring and shine in summer.

A journalist sets out to create his digital double by drawing on his personal data and using existing technologies, including Artificial Intelligence. The development of his virtual replica confronts him with his own limits. What meaning can be given to life if machines can replace humans? Each advance in Al raises new ethical and existential questions. Will the journalist go through with the experiment? Will he come out of it unscathed?



Amazon: looking for new species 1x52'

A team of scientists go on an expedition to a yet unexplored area of the Brazilian Amazonia in order to discover new animal and vegetal species to better protect these ecosystems.

Bora Bora, lab for the future 1x52'




Bora Bora is the most popular destination in French Polynesia, certainly because of its lagoon, considered the most beautiful lagoon in the world. In this context, the islet could have sunk under concrete and pollution, and the reef could have been irreparably impacted. However, thanks to the will of a handful of inhabitants, including the mayor of the island, Bora Bora is today a model of sustainable development, with water treatment technologies that are 15 years ahead of France, programs for restoring corals and safeguarding wildlife, educational actions and rehabilitation of Polynesian traditions such as the "rahui" and the establishment of a monitoring network using new technologies.



The documentary aims to enlighten zoo visitors by indicating what they should notice when visiting these facilities. With the help of specialists whose insights offer extremely diverse perspectives, the documentary does not aim to condemn zoos but rather to encourage good behaviors by turning each visitor into a witness of the practices, whether acceptable or reprehensible, specific to each organization.



Some friendships go even deeper: Lucie (46) made the life-changing decision to donate a kidney to her long-time friend Aude (44), strengthening their already unique connection.



FACTUAL

Bless our breasts 1x90' or 1x52'

Bless our breasts is a documentary that explores the perception and representation of the female chest in society. It examines how this part of the body, often sexualized, is shaped by social and cultural expectations. The film looks at the pressures faced from a young age, when the chest becomes a symbol of femininity, and addresses practices such as "breast flattening" and cosmetic surgery, which alter bodies to fit certain societal ideals. Through testimonies and analysis, the documentary examines how these norms affect body image and invites reflection on the relationship women have with their own bodies.

In the 1970s, cleaning staff at the Université Catholique de Louvain threw out their bosses and set up their own cleaning cooperative, Le Balai Libéré. 50 years later, the cleaning staff at UCLouvain meet yesterday's workers: is working without a boss still an option?

For everyone, Eiffel is the Tower, the symbol of Paris. But who was Gustave Eiffel, the man who built this mythical monument?

Fifty ships pass through the port every day.

More than 15,000 employees work 24 hours a day to take care of the goods, sometimes risking their lives, as port jobs are so dangerous: sailors, pilots, customs officers, dockers, etc.

From the arrival of the goods to their delivery, this documentary follows this chain of work throughout.

Hey, check out my penis 1x45'

This film explores the phenomenon of «dick pics»—unsolicited photos of penises—by examining the motivations of the men who send them and the impact on those who receive them. Through firsthand accounts, expert analysis, and a non-judgmental approach, the documentary examines themes such as desire, power, exhibitionism, narcissism, sexism, and fear of rejection. The aim is to understand the reasons behind this phenomenon and to open a dialogue on sexuality and consent.

Shot on the occasion of her 50th birthday, this film follows Bamby Salcedo as she makes plans to throw herself a "Queenciañera" party and reflects on her amazing journey from Guadalajara, Mexico to living as an addict in LA's Skid Row to winning her first job with the LGBTQIA+community when she was fresh out of recovery. She started from the bottom, reached for the top, and is still going to this day. Now a nationally and internationally known Latina Transgender activist and founder of the TransLatin@ Coalition, Salcedo takes the phrase "never give up" to a whole new level. Salcedo is inspiring new generations to get involved in LGBTQIA+ activism, and it's a good thing because with the recent tremendous backlash against trans people, it is needed more than ever.

Women in prison 1x52'


Even though they are outnumbered, France still has 2,600 female inmates, representing around 3% of the prison population. Only two prisons are specifically reserved for them: the Rennes penitentiary and the Versailles prison. Most inmates serve their sentences in one of the 59 "women's quarters", including Réau in Seine-et-Marne, where we were exceptionally able to set up our cameras for several weeks.



HISTORY

Wreck hunters 40x22'

Wreck hunter Samuel Côté takes us into the depths of the Saint Lawrence River, in search of treasures buried for decades or even centuries. Accompanied by his team of divers, he tracks down the ships lying in the river's abyss and brings their mysteries back to life. The series immerses viewers in Quebec's maritime history, through stories of wars, pirates, treasures, and archaeology. The adventure is risky, but the discoveries are thrilling and allow Samuel to fulfill his mission: to restore the river's history.
