How did this grandson of a slave become a literary giant?

Meanwhile, Michael, Mathieu, Sebastien, and Fabien are working on restoring a 12th-century castle in the Drôme region, a challenging but exciting adventure. In Charente, the «bande des mussets,» a group of inseparable friends aged 22 to 27, center their lives around their bond, celebrating every milestone together. Some friendships go even deeper: Lucie (46) made the life-changing decision to donate a kidney to her long-time friend Aude (44), strengthening their already unique connection.



Beyond Everest

Because yes, we can all enjoy eating without disrupting the ocean.



Eiffel, the last secrets

Havre harbour: a world of excess

A true economic hub, the port of Le Havre is France's leading port for foreign trade: a gigantic platform which receives 68 million tonnes of goods each year.

With exceptional infrastructure, Le Havre is capable of accommodating the largest container ships in the world.

Fifty ships pass through the port every day.

More than 15,000 employees work 24 hours a day to take care of the goods, sometimes risking their lives, as port jobs are so dangerous: sailors, pilots, customs officers, dockers, etc.

From the arrival of the goods to their delivery, this documentary follows this chain of work throughout.

She started from the bottom, reached for the top, and is still going to this day. Now a nationally and internationally known Latina Transgender activist and founder of the TransLatin@ Coalition, Salcedo takes the phrase "never give up" to a whole new level. Salcedo is inspiring new generations to get involved in LGBTQIA+ activism, and it's a good thing because with the recent tremendous backlash against trans people, it is needed more than ever.

Near my dung

A source of wonder, games or artistic creation, the dung is teeming with intense activity. Its inhabitants are surprising and amusing heroes whose unsuspected morals we will discover. Myriad insects need dung to feed, meet others and lay eggs. For others it is a coveted hunting ground. Irreplaceable recyclers, dung and the animals that depend on it are a necessary link in our planet's ecosystems. They are essential to life. Dung brings together those who enjoy it, questions those who contemplate it, enchants those who transform it. Yes, but here it is, Ivermectin, this anti-parasitic product administered by some to cows, found intact in the dung and kills the dung beetles which consume it. And the chain continues: hoopoes, foxes, badgers, bats and hedgehogs which are fond of dung beetles are also impacted. Dung beetles are gradually disappearing.

Women in prison

Even though they are outnumbered, France still has 2,600 female inmates, representing around 3% of the prison population. Only two prisons are specifically reserved for them: the Rennes penitentiary and the Versailles prison. Most inmates serve their sentences in one of the 59 “women’s quarters”, including Réau in Seine-et-Marne, where we were exceptionally able to set up our cameras for several weeks.

Wreck hunters

Accompanied by his team of divers, he tracks down the ships lying in the river's abyss and brings their mysteries back to life. The series immerses viewers in Quebec's maritime history, through stories of wars, pirates, treasures, and archaeology. The adventure is risky, but the discoveries are thrilling and allow Samuel to fulfill his mission: to restore the river's history.



Zoo, a gilded cage

Are zoos suitable environments for wild animals? This documentary focuses on the exploitation of animals for entertainment. Although circus animals are now considered relics of a barbaric era, we continue to support very profitable businesses that exploit wild animals, which, even in the best conditions, live lives that are not their own. The documentary aims to enlighten zoo visitors by indicating what they should notice when visiting these facilities. With the help of specialists whose insights offer extremely diverse perspectives, the documentary does not aim to condemn zoos but rather to encourage good behaviors by turning each visitor into a witness of the practices, whether acceptable or reprehensible, specific to each organization.

A year at Pic du Midi

The Pic du Midi de Bigorre is a multi-faceted mountain, an old lady whose history is rich in several lives and whose aura dominates an entire territory. With the installation of a scientific platform, then an astronomical observatory, with its recent opening to the general public, it has been able to constantly evolve and reinvent itself. To portray this mountain is to hear the science that is practiced there, the history that is transmitted there, the tourism that it engenders, the poetry that emerges from it. "The 4 seasons of the Pic du Midi" accompanies this old lady over time, listening to fall asleep at fall, roar in winter, calm down in spring and shine in summer.

AI, to be or not to be

3x52' - format

For the first time, a documentary series questions the limits of human beings, in an era where machines are becoming more and more intelligent.

A journalist sets out to create his digital double by drawing on his personal data and using existing technologies, including Artificial Intelligence. The development of his virtual replica confronts him with his own limits. What meaning can be given to life if machines can replace humans? Each advance in AI raises new ethical and existential questions. Will the journalist go through with the experiment? Will he come out of it unscathed?
