Here it wakes up and, in doing so, releases greenhouse gases that accelerate its own thawing, but also bacteria and viruses. It could even harbor countless infectious foci. What are the scientists' predictions? Is it already too late?

Bora Bora is the most popular destination in French Polynesia, certainly because of its lagoon, considered the most beautiful lagoon in the world. In this context, the islet could have sunk under concrete and pollution, and the reef could have been irreparably impacted. However, thanks to the will of a handful of inhabitants, including the mayor of the island, Bora Bora is today a model of sustainable development, with water treatment technologies that are 15 years ahead of France, programs for restoring corals and safeguarding wildlife, educational actions and rehabilitation of Polynesian traditions such as the "rahui" and the establishment of a monitoring network using new technologies. All this makes the island a veritable open-air laboratory that shows the way for all tropical coastal environments around the world.

Reno rivals

The only home renovation competition series that gives you three before-and-after comparisons per episode! Reno Rivals is a renovation competition where we follow three construction sites as three teams try to complete their renovations in three weeks. Participants visit each other to witness the «before» and «after,» and admire the final result. They vote on each other's work based on three criteria: the quality of the work, the layout/ergonomics, and the general impression. A construction expert also judges the teams' work, and his vote counts for one third of the final score.

Wreck hunters

In Wreck hunters, see historian Samuel Côté and skilled diver Mario Cyr team up to unravel the secrets behind Canada's seabed. Accompanied by a team of collaborators and armed with state-of-the-art detection tools, they will follow the trail of documented remains, but not necessarily located, in order to uncover as many remains of ships, planes or artefacts linked to exciting stories.

AI, to be or not to be

For the first time, a documentary series questions the limits of human beings, in an era where machines are becoming more and more intelligent. A journalist sets out to create his digital double by drawing on his personal data and using existing technologies, including Artificial Intelligence. The development of his virtual replica confronts him with his own limits. What meaning can be given to life if machines can replace humans? Each advance in AI raises new ethical and existential questions. Will the journalist go through with the experiment? Will he come out of it unscathed?

Serial testers

Weekly 52' & Format

A band of testers carry out spectacular experiments to confirm (or debunk) popular beliefs. Installed in a workshop shed, Agathe Lecaron, Vincent Chatelain, David Lowe and James the crush dummy, use laboratory resources (wind, crash test, etc..) and tests, that they will conduct themselves. Can we go faster than the wind? Can we fly with balloons? Can we walk on water? All those questions will find an answer thanks to our incredible science team!
