#### Zero waste Kitchen

A country where today 33 million people are starving and about a third of its population has some kind of food vulnerability. Chef Edson Leite has come up with a way to use the full potential of all ingredients, with just one rule: no waste. When Edson came back to Brazil, he started to teach vulnerable communities in favelas how to eat better while spending less money.





#### Fashion Africa
